A warning message appears when users do not select a valid value for String type parameters. This is because the prompting engine considers the empty value to be an empty string, and empty strings are valid; therefore, the prompting engine searches the list of values for the String dynamic parameter. When the engine fails to find a match for an empty string in the list, it provides a warning message to ask users to enter a valid value again. But for Number/Currency/DateTime/Date/Time/Boolean type dynamic parameter, if users don't select a value, the prompting engine considers the value invalid; therefore, the engine sets the focus back to select control directly, bypassing the warning message.
