## VMware Support

Many of our clients are running applications and operating systems under vmware. Business Objects also makes extensive use of vmware\*\* within the Business Objects development, IT and support organizations to create various Windows and Linux environments. Business Objects is not aware of ANY specific issues with Business Objects software products\* and vmware at this time.

While Business Objects products are expected to function properly in virtual environments, there may be performance implications, which can invalidate Business Objects' typical sizing and recommended setting guidelines. Analysis must be performed within the context of the specific application to be hosted in a virtual environment to minimize potential resource contention, which can have significant impact on performance and scalability, particularly under peak load.

In order to facilitate a quick resolution and root cause to any potential Business Objects product issue encountered under vmware, Business Objects has established some basic guidelines for supporting Business Objects software in a vmware environment:

- All versions and configurations of applications and operating systems (kernels included) running under vmware must already be certified and listed in the applicable Product Availability Report (PAR).
- The client is responsible for properly configuring their virtual machine and applications for vmware.
- While Business Objects does not insist that clients recreate each issue without vmware before contacting support, we reserve the right to request the client diagnose and troubleshoot specific issues without the vmware "variable". This will only be done where we have reason to believe the issue is directly related to vmware.
- In the event that Business Objects support cannot directly identify the root cause as a Business Objects or vmware issue, support would ask the client to open a support issue with vmware and any other necessary 3rd party vendors to expedite the resolution of the issue. At that point, Business Objects, vmware, and the client can work together toward a quick resolution.

As stated above, there are no known issues running Business Objects software with vmware.
